Landmarks in the Historical Development of 21st Century of Food Processing Technologies*

Police Inspector of Ullal Police Station explained the causes and impacts of ragging and the acts related to ragging; how offensive it is to commit such a crime, and the measures taken by the government to eradicate ragging. He also mentioned a few cases related to ragging that he has handled. He stressed the importance of student life, hard work and the sacrifices of their parents to make their future bright. He said that all the students are not from the same background, and not all are strong enough to face humiliation made by their seniors and their classmates.

He made the students realize that once the criminal data is recorded then it is updated throughout the country's criminal record and it becomes very difficult for the accused to travel abroad for work or studies. It is a black mark if the student is a part of ragging and he/she may be dismissed from the college and nowhere else admissions would be given.

Mr. Shek Isak, Advocate & Notary, Mangaluru spoke about ragging issues & its consequences. He insisted students not to indulge in ragging and explained about Anti-Ragging laws.

Ms. Nazhath Banu, Advocate, Mangaluru, gave a brief information on Anti-ragging, its causes, effects, and impacts on the victims who have been ragged. She also gave examples where the victims have committed suicide because of the ragging issue.

The Guest of Honor Mr. Raghavendra S, Deputy Manager, National Stock Exchange Academy said that the faculty who attend this program will be able to educate their students concerning investments.

Prof. KS Jayappa, Finance Officer, Mangalore University delivered the presidential remarks. Dr. V. Ravindrachary, Nodal Officer - NEP 2020 gave the overview of the faculty development programme.

He oriented the teachers about mutual funds, its schemes, and the criteria to be followed for the selection of mutual funds.

Public Speaking Session for Faculty Members

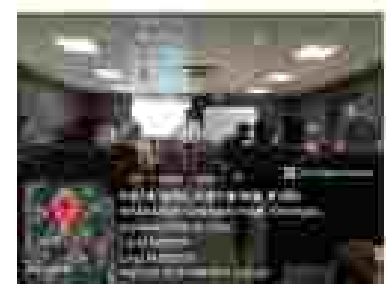

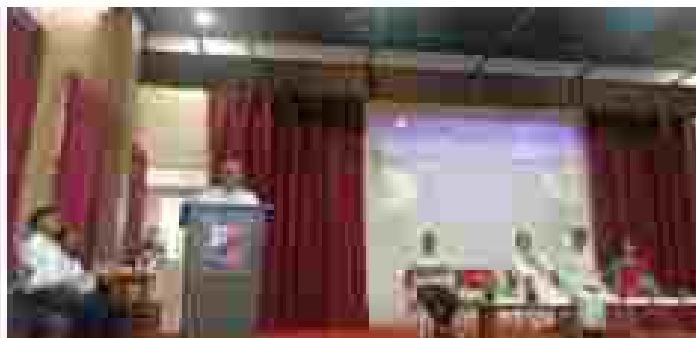
OUTREACH PROGRAMS

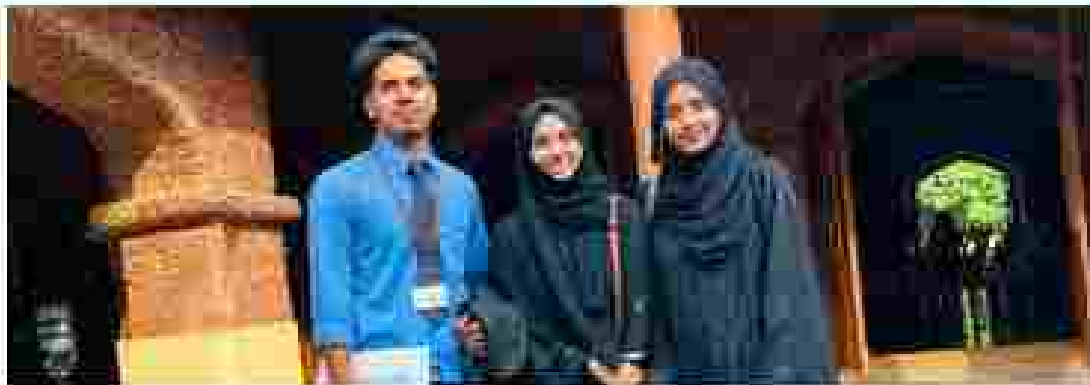
Felicitation of Student

Discussions on Immersion Programs with ISDC



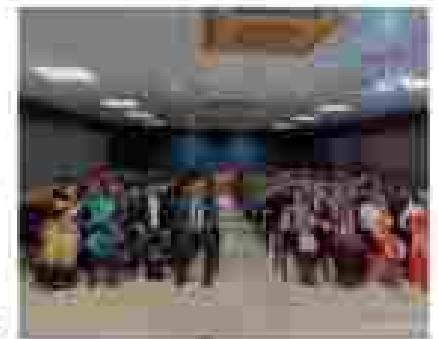

He highlighted the changes in the refund process, the procedure to claim the refund, the forms to be utilized for filing the refund, the documents to be uploaded to claim the refund, and the time limit for claiming the refund.
