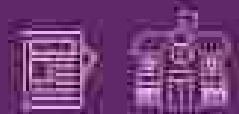

Converting Total Kitchen Solid Waste into Compost for feeding plants



Environmental Cell of PAFGC initiated a project on converting kitchen solid waste into compost on 14th Mar 2023. The earthen harri-pot was placed in food preparation lab of Food Science Department, PAFGC, so that the kitchen solid waste can be dropped into the earthen harri-pot.

It requires a minimum of 90 days for the kitchen solid waste to get converted into compost. When the compost is ready, it is dried in sunlight for 2 days and then fed to the plants. This is a great initiative of PAFGC concerning the environmental factors in developing the clean and green campus.

The project was inaugurated by Prof C V Rujar, Dept. of Mechanical Engineering, P A College of Engineering with the presence of Dr Surfraz J Hasim, Principal, PAFGC, Capt. Rudresh, Campus Supervisor and other staffs of PAFGC on 14th Mar 2023.

On 07 Feb 2024, the compost was fed to the plants in the campus.

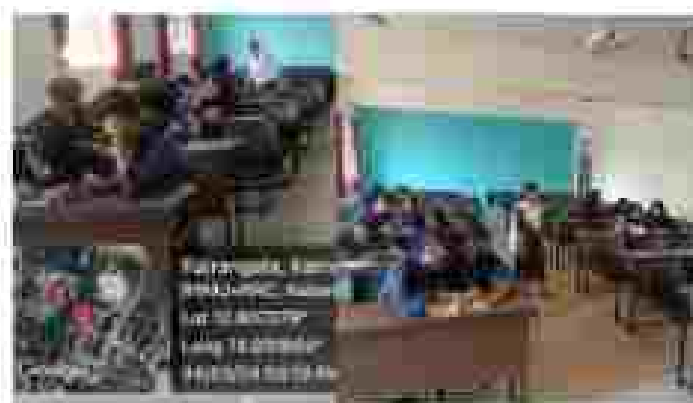

Women's Day Celebration

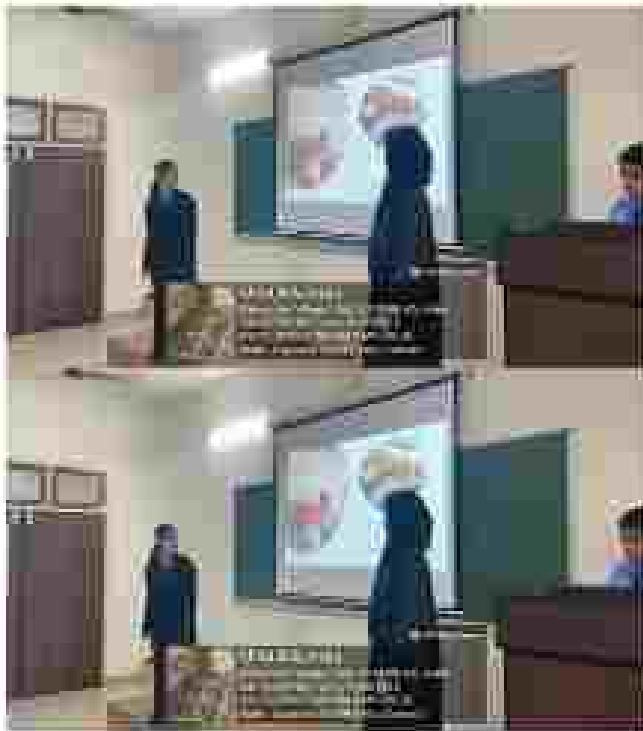

The session ended with clarifying the doubts with the students in regard to material available online and other concerned matters to the subject.

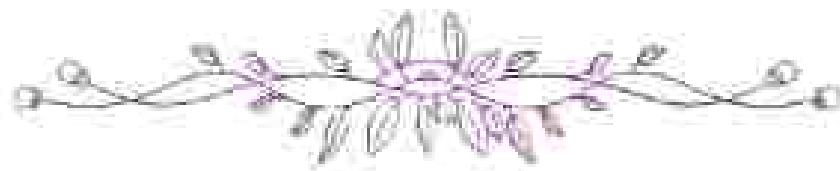
